## **Program Overview**

The UAB Medicine Teen Volunteer Leadership Program is a leadership experience for high school students who have previously participated in UAB Medicine's Teen Volunteer Program. Four applicants from each session will be selected to serve on the leadership team. Selection will be based on prior participation, application, recommendation and overall fit for the program.

- Previous Attendance in UAB Medicine's Teen Volunteer Program
- TVP Leadership Team Application
- Letter of Recommendation specific to leadership program
- Acceptance to the 2026 Teen Volunteer Program

- Develop leadership and communication skills in a real-world healthcare environment
- Strengthen volunteer engagement and accountability through peer influence
- Provide meaningful leadership experience
- Foster confidence, responsibility, and professionalism
